10. Official expenses for representative players and guest officials

Below is a list of expenses which will be paid by KABA.

- 1) Accommodation and meals September $3^{\text{rd}} 9^{\text{th}}$
- Participants who wish to stay longer than the period are required to pay all extra

costs. In this case, you must inform us about your plan (visiting places & purpose), place to stay (hotel name and address), and emergency contact during the extended period.

- Participants will share a hotel room with another player.

Participants will move to Buan/Incheon together by bus on Day 1 and Day 6. It takes approximately 3.5 hours.
