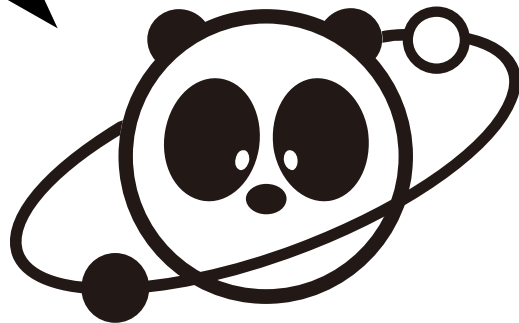

Individuals' and team tournament.

Besides evaluating individuals teams are also evaluated.

- Hungarian clubs and foreign nations can form teams consisting of four persons, if possible. If there is only one team, it may consist of three or even two players. If three persons remain after creating the four person teams, and they would like to take part in the team tournament from the same club / nation, they also can register as a team. If only one or two persons remain, one of the four-person teams must be reduced to three persons, and two three-person teams, or one three-person and one two-person team must be registered.
- The evaluation of the team tournament is based on the number of wins, all the wins of the team is divided by the number of members.

We ask the leaders of the clubs / nations groups to control the creating of teams!!!!

Ferenc Erkel

Born in 1810, Gyula, he was one of the greatest Hungarian composers, composer of the Hungarian National Anthem. He often visited Budakeszi, where he could rest and produce in the summer-resort of family Erkel. Not only did he prevail as a composer, but as a chess player as well. He was among the founders and the first vice-president of the first official chess organization in Hungary, the "Chess Circle in Pest" founded in 1864. For this we honour him as a pioneer of mind sports in Hungary.
